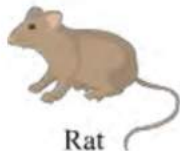

Question 2: How do you keep your house clean?

- i. Sweeping the floor and collecting the dust in the dustbins
- ii. Mopping the floor
- iii. Using phenyl and disinfectant for cleaning the floor and washrooms
- iv. Removing cobwebs periodically
- v. Using insect and mosquito repellent
- vi. Throwing out wastes only in the dustbin (recyclable and non-recyclable wastes should be thrown separately)
- vii. Getting the house white-washed periodically
