Q1: Define veld.

Ans: The temperate grassland of South Africa are called veld. veld are rolling plateaus with varying height ranging from 600 m to 1100 m .It is bounded by Drakenburg mountain in the east, to its west lies the Kalahari desert. On the north-eastern part, high veld are located that attain a height of more than 1600 m in some place.
