Introduction to HTML

HTML (Hyper Text Markup Language) language is developed by Tim Burner-Lee at CERN (Consiel European pour la Research Nuclear) to enable the researchers to share their research papers with the help of the Internet. Generally all the browsers are supporting HTML but basically the HTML was used by Mosaic Browser. The HTML 1.0 is the first version of HTML. W3C (World Wide Web) is the organization which did not specify the first version of HTML. This organization maintains the language and keeps involving for development of HTML. Latest version of HTML is HTML 4.01 which is in general use and is the sub version of HTML4.0. The errors which are occurring in HTML4.0 have been fixed in this version.

The whole HTML document comes under the <html>tag which is used as a container. The entire content of the HTML page comes under the opening and closing of the <html>tags. This <html>tag indicates the browser this is the starting of the document and the closing </html>tag indicates that it's the ending of an HTML document. Syntax of HTML document:

For the Heading of the HTML document the tag which is used is <head>tag. The information contains some certain headings regarding document that comes under this. There are only few tags which are valid under the heading section. These are the following:

<link>tag: Defines reference for the resource.

<base>tag:- Defines a base URL (Uniform Resource Locator) for all the links present on a page

<meta>tag:- Defines the Meta- Information such as keyword and descriptions for search engines and refresh rates about the page.

<script>tag:-The HTML page uses the script defined by this tag.

<style>tag:- Defines the internal style sheet for the HTML page.

The contents of the HTML document are described under the <body>tag. The contents of a web page whatever are they defined between the opening and closing of the <body>tag, it may be a text, audio, video and images all comes under this tag.



Web Page

For accessing any information on the Internet, the system WWW (World Wide Web) is used. It's one of the graphical parts of the internet. The WWW consists of files or Web pages that contain information and links to resources throughout the Internet.



You can surf or browse the Web in several ways:

- ❖ Any of the Web pages can be opened by typing its address in the address box of your Web browsing software.
- ❖ While viewing a Web page, you can browse or surf to the related sites by clicking the links on the page.
- ❖ Toolbar buttons can also be used to move between Web pages, refresh Web page's contents or search the Internet.



Introduction to Microsoft Internet Explorer

IE (Internet Explorer) is one of the most popular Internet browser that was developed by Microsoft. The first version of IE was IE1 that was launched in 1995. Microsoft continually works on the enhancement of IE. Currently Microsoft is working on IE 9. The IE 8 is the latest version of IE. The IE2, IE3, IE4, IE5, IE6 and IE 7 are the older version of IE. For performing various tasks on the Internet you can use the explorer toolbar.



The following list shows the description of each button:

- ❖ **Back** : Moves to a previously viewed page.
- ❖ **Forward** : Moves to next Web page.
- ❖ **Stop** : Stops the execution of a Web page.
- ❖ **Refresh** : Updates the currently displayed Web page.
- ❖ **Home**: Jumps to your home page.
- ❖ **Search** : Opens a Web page that lists the available search engines.
- ❖ **Favorites** : Displays a list of Web pages you have designated as your favourites.
- ❖ **History** : Displays a list of recently visited sites.
- ❖ **Channels** : Displays a list of channels you can select.
- ❖ **Full Screen**: Uses a smaller standard toolbar and hides the address bar so that more of the screen can be visible.
- ❖ **Mail**: Opens outlook Express or the Internet News.
- ❖ **Print**: Is used to print a Web page.

E-mail

Email (Electronic mail) is a digital correspondence that provides the facility to send and receive text messages, picture files and any other file to and from anyone with an e-mail address. E-mail is fast, easy and inexpensive. Email is a formal conversation. It should be point to point and well written.

In current market there are many service providers who provide free e-mail services on the Internet, such as www.gmail.com, www.yahoo.com, www.hotmail.com and www.msn.com. The first part of the email address is a user name. The second part or domain name defines the Internet provider where the mail is sent. The two parts are separated by '@' sign (pronounced as "at the rate"). The domain name is followed by an extension that indicates the type of organization to which the network belongs.



The following is an example of an email address:

Steve@gmail.com

To send mail:

- ❖ Start your e-mail program and click the Compose New message option. Depending on your e-mail program, the name of this button may vary.
- ❖ In the 'To' text box, type the address of the recipient or click on a name in the address book.
- ❖ Type a short description of your e-mail on the subject line.
- ❖ Click the message area and type your message.
- ❖ Click Send to send the message.



Hypertext Transfer Protocol (HTTP)

HTTP is the most important protocol used in WWW. It is a protocol that allows transferring the information on the World Wide Web between clients and servers. The main purpose of the HTTP is publishing and retrieving of the Web pages. The latest version of HTTP is HTTP/1.1. The original version of HTTP is HTTP 1.0. The main feature of HTTP 1.0 is that it uses a separate connection to the same server for every document.



Web Servers

A web server is a computer application that delivers web pages using HTTP over the World Wide Web. Basically it is responsible for accepting HTTP requests from clients or web browser. It also processes the requests send by the client and then sends the HTTP response back to the client.



Hyperlink

Hyperlink allows linking another place in the same document or another document. It also allows to link with the World Wide Web. A user just needs to click on hyperlink to go for relevant destination.



Hypertext

Hypertext is a kind of text that contains the reference of other text that exists in the same or other electronic document or the World Wide Web. A reader can immediately access the relevant information by just clicking or pressing the key on hypertext.



Working with the CD-Player

Now a day CD players are easily available in number of varieties and users are more confused about it. A CD player which you have opted for, contains basically three main features- a tracking device, derive motor, laser and a lens system. Basically derive motor needs pace not more than 200 rpm, but some time it needs approx 500 rpm also. Whereas the tracking device adjust the laser assembly and thus makes it possible for laser and lens system to work in a proper manner for the data which is stored on the CD (Compact Disk).
