


ENDOCRINE SYSTEM





NEGATIVE FEEDBACK LOOPS



Gland	Hormone	Function
Pituitary (master gland) Base of brain	Growth hormone Tropic hormones Vasopressin (ADH) Oxytocin	Growth of muscles and bones Regulates secretion of other hormones Regulates water content Aids childbirth and lactation
Adrenal Above kidney	Adrenaline Cortisone	Prepares body to meet emergencies Regulates metabolism
Thyroid Neck region	Thyroxin	Regulates basal metabolism, influences general growth and mental development
Pancreas	Insulin Glucagon	Decreases blood sugar level Increases blood sugar levels
