- ☐ Prime Minister is the head of the cabinet.
- ☐ Prime Minister is the executive head of the state.
- ☐ He can suggest the president of India about the resignation or removed of any minister from his cabinet.
- ☐ If the Prime Minister resigns from his post or office, the cabinet stops functioning.






