India's Rakshabandhan festivities became sweeter, with our "Chanda Mama" getting a Rakhi from "Mother India".

As per tradition, Chanda Mama will now take care of all of us! (of course through scientific progress and insight into space and its origin).

The news of Chandrayan-3 landing on Moon was replete with images of ISRO scientists clapping and

dancing in joy. Meanwhile, an older image of K. Sivan breaking down in PM Modi's arms brought jitters down the Indian's memory, with flashbacks of the sorrow when Chandrayaan-2 couldn't make a soft landing on moon.

ISRO proved like none other, that when you keep your face to the sunshine, you cannot see a shadow. ISRO proved its worth when people had started raising doubts on its humungous budget, which could have been used for developmental needs of India.

It was proved that when one focusses on the opportunities and one's well wishes and utilize one's strength in the right direction, the challenges naturally take a back seat and success prevails.

Not the first Incident....

India had faced similar instances earlier too. Our humongous constitution was mocked at and called a "lawyers paradise". Ivor Jennings went to the extent of saying that India would break into smaller units because of such constitution.

Despite such provocation, we kept on putting efforts to put our nation together - from Patel's plan of integration of princely states to Nehruji's Tribal Paanchsheel Plan, we sustained and survived.

Meanwhile, Ivor Jennings was re-writing Sri Lanka's constitution, 6 years after he had drafted it, due to its inherent weaknesses to accommodate diversity.

When we try to build a larger picture and focus on what can be rebuilt from the trash, it is our way of focussing on the positives of a situation - a manifestation of positive attitude.

POSITIVE ATTITUDE - The foundation

Positive attitude ensures that we look at the brighter side of the picture, at the glass half-filled and take life as it comes.

When Thomas Alva Edison's laboratory was ablaze, which had all his experiments and samples, he asked his son to call his mother. "Call your mom, she wouldn't have ever seen such a huge bonfire".

His attitude turned the situation upside down, He took it

as setting off his failures on fire
and to start afresh - at the "tender"
age of 56.

This philosophy remains true at
national level as well. Bangladesh,
a small nation, which gained
independence after us, has done
remarkably well in human indicator
rankings

They chose to develop their human
capital through whatever small resources
they had. It is the sheer will, that
can help a person or nation to
change a situation upside down,
despite all the persisting challenges.

SALT: The Spice of all

Adverse situations require adverse
reactions and when is scarce of
resources, there is a need to

utilize the smallest powerful weapon at hand.

Unable to challenge the mighty British with power, Gaudiji chose "salt"! who would have thought that this small act of picking salt and using it for fight against the British, would have turned into such a Grand Movement.

The ability to not get affected by diverse viewpoints and instead focusing on one's own deeds, led this to happen. Perhaps, all social reformers follow similar principles.

REFORMS : A CASE IN POINT

When reformers stand up against a cause, it is well a part of everyday morality and ethics. Rising against the tide, does have its own fallout. People might not listen to you or worse

are might be subject to violence.

But, it was absolute grit of people like Raja Ram Mohan Roy, Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar who fought against Sati and plight of widows. Savitribai Phule was so busy in social reforms, that during the bubonic plague, while treating the patients, she herself caught the disease and died..

Even in present times, the grit of reformers remain undefeatable. Malala Yousafzai despite the death threats, still worked for women's education.

People like "Greta Thunberg" and her speech "How Dare You?", rose up against the most powerful lobbies. She was still able to leave

a mark because of her will power to challenge the system and move towards a sustainable future.

Sometimes, such action is collective and leaves a huge trail behind. chipko Movement was a collective movement of "not so powerful" tribal women, but their resolve to bring change, brought success. Similar is the case with scientific explorations.

The science of it

Scientific discoveries are often a result of people ridiculing the new theories and sticking to their old beliefs. Be it the heliocentric theory or theory of evolution, all were accompanied with stories of mistrust and people raising doubts.

This didn't deter scientists of any age or century and we have come to point where we have divertless cars, generative AI, robots working for humans and machines carrying out large scale works.

Had the "shadows of dogmas" stifled science, we would have continued to live in caves!

The Side Effects

Sometime it is imperative upon us to look at the shadows. They may hold the plight of the poor, inequality, developmental deficit and most severe of all - hunger.

This undercurrent shouldn't be brushed under the carpet to ensure solidarity of the society. Our developmental plans shouldn't be

so opportunity led, that in the process we lose the humane touch of it. with India's rank on hunger index 107/121, 22% Poverty (Tendulkar committee), 29/50 world's most polluted cities in India, it becomes all the more imperative to focus on the shadows!

History has taught us that neglecting the shadows, often lead to protest - be it French Revolution, Russian Revolution, all occurred due neglect of shadows! shadows of hunger, poverty and disdain.

The 'Anti-thesis'

But, what if its raining? In such a case forget about the sun and shadows, just take shelter and wait

for the condition to become favourable.
Give the situation some time and
you will find yourself in better
circumstances.

COVID was such a case. Temporary
fire fighting to get people vaccines,
food and medicine hijacked all other
plans and we took shelter in the
rains.

Thus, to conclude its necessary to
focus on the "good" and ignore the
"other". A positive attitude along with
circumstances favourable to oneself
are bound to deliver results.

Having said that, do focus
on the shadow sometimes as

they might have "pearls of wisdom" in them, alongwith years of injustice and deprivation.

Also, dont forget to save oneself from the rains - as the situation, people and above all the environment might not be favourable at all.

In the words of Tagore,

" where the mind is without fear and the head is held high let my country rise in such situation "
