On the night of Friday November 13, 1998, as India and Zimbabwe clashed in the final of the Coca Cola Cup at Sharjah, school children who were participating in the 'shot gun shoots' talk show over Star TV, loudly declared that their favourite cricketer was Sachin Tendulkar. It was easy to understand their choice. The Doordarshan direct telecast of the Sharjah match showed Tendulkar single-handedly annihilating the Zimbabwe players. Skittling out Zimbabwe for 196, the 'Hit Pair' of Tendulkar and Saurav Ganguly, passed that score, enabling India to register an easy ten wicket win. Tendulkar played like a man possessed. His 124 not out, came from just 92 balls. He hit the ball as he liked. Six sixers and 12 boundaries flowed from his bat. Tendulkar was the 'Man of the Match'.

Kiran Bedi (1949 –) is a social activist and a retired Indian Police Service Officer. She became the first woman to join the IPS in 1972. She was soon gained a reputation as a fearless and forthright officer. 
