1) **Carpenter:** a person who makes or repairs wooden objects Example sentences:

2) **Queer:** strange or odd Example sentences:

- 1) Her queer behaviour in the school surprised me.
- 2) I have many queer friends.

3) **Plane:** completely flat Example sentences:

- 1) The old friends sat on a plane surface.
- 2) Chop the vegetables on a plane surface.

4) **Puzzled:** unable to understand Example sentences:

- 1) I was puzzled by my mother's question.
- 2) Jasmine gave a puzzled look to me.

5) **Puppet:** model of a person or an animal moved by strings Example sentences:

- 1) Our relatives decided to watch a puppet show.
- 2) Puppets look very cute dancing on stage.

6) **Took shape:** to develop a clear form Example sentences:

- 1) My ideas **took shape** in a while.
 - 2) The vase **took shape** in the potter's hands.
- 7) **Amazed**: surprised Example sentences:
- 1) She was **amazed** to see the beautiful beaches in Kerela.
 - 2) Jaya was **amazed** to see her mother at the airport.
- 8) **Finished**: to bring to an end Example sentences:
- 1) I had **finished** my homework on time.
 - 2) The little girl **finished** her food.
- 9) **Stiff**: rigid or strong Example sentences:
- 1) The letter was very **stiff**.
 - 2) Raj's shirt had a **stiff** collar.
- 10) **Decided**: to make up your mind to do something Example sentences:
- 1) She **decided** to study for an hour.
 - 2) The judge **decided** to hold the case.
