## Page No 201:

### **Question Tell:**

- Did all the farmers in Dhanu's village have their own land?

### Answer:

- If people in Dhanu's village did not leave the village in search of work, what difficulties would they face in their own village?
- In Dhanu's village, there can be no farming when there is no rain. Do you think farming can be done even without rain water? How?

#### Answer:

- If people in Dhanu's village did not leave in search of work, then they would have no money to buy food and other needs. They would come under the debt of loan taken from the *mukadam* every year, which they had to return after earning money by working out of the village.
- Yes, farming can be done without rain water through irrigation. Irrigation is a process of watering the plants manually through wells, tube-wells, canals, harvested rain water, etc.
