Useful hints for solving comprehension

- Read the given passage carefully. Remember that a good paragraph revolves round a single idea.
- Follow the line of development that the writer has given. Separate the explanations, example, and quotations from the main concern.
- Try to paraphrase the important portions of the passage, as you start writing the answer.
- Never try to explain the questions or given your opinions.
- Write your answer brief, precise and to the point.
- Your answer must consist of complete and self-explanatory sentences.
- Always use the same tense as used in the question.
- Always use the third person.

- Be brief and to the point.
- Write one or two words, as specified in the blanks.
- Increase your stock of vocabulary.
- Revise your answer and correct your spelling/grammatical errors.
