

On the 20<sup>th</sup> of August 2019, the whole of world was enamoured in a shroud of silence for it was at that moment the Vikram lander lost contact and Chandrayan-2 mission was considered a failure. Tears filled the eyes of then Chairman T. Sivan and the millions of Indians witnessing the scene.

Four years later tragedy again struck when Luna-25 of Roscosmos again attempted to make a soft landing on the South pole of moon but was blasted to smithereens.

Back to back failures and setbacks

made it seem impossible to land on the far side of moon. But 'where there is will there is a way'. By the ingenuity, labour, hardwork and dedication of scientists of ISRO, India became the 1<sup>st</sup> and only country to soft land on the south pole of moon in the evening of 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2023, marking the grand success of Chandrayaan-3, the successor to so called 'failure' of a mission of Chandrayaan-2.

This incident highlights the fact that even when all seems lost, when no one believes in us, ridicules our effort, through constant and hard effort and a clear vision. everything is possible for

In this essay we will see how failure affects a person. How after failure we can either better ourselves and tackle with it or how we can be bitter about it. We will also highlight how sometimes failing is better than succeeding and what effects it has. So Lets Begin!

## From a caterpillar to a Butterfly

A caterpillar is often considered one of the ugliest lifeforms on Earth, people consider it slimy, gross and unredeeming of any good qualities, but when the same caterpillar cocoons into a butterfly, the same people are in awe of it and consider it the most beautiful thing on planet with its magnificent and gorgeous wings.

Similar is the case with human society, it awards the winners and stomps on the failures. History is a testament to this fact.

According to the old testament in Christian mythology, Noah had a premonition about the great flood, he tried to warn all but to no avail. King Louis XVI along with his wife Marie Antoinette were the emperor and empress of France in 18<sup>th</sup> Century CE. However in a feudal France with growing poverty and ravishing hunger they kept a very bourgeois attitude with the Empress remarking "let them eat cake", as a taunt to the millions of hungry subject. The rulers only cared about their own luxury and comfort and turned a blind eye to the misery of the poor.

However this elitist narrow vision became their downfall, for the rising resentment among the mass exploded in the form of French Revolution of 1789 leading to the guillotine of the couple.

The tale of King Louis XVI tells us how a narrow field of view is harmful and how we should ground ourselves to reality.

In this essay we will see the issue of looking a unidimensional way. We will shed light on approach to a multidimensional strategy. We will also look upon the problems faced by a narrow field of vision and solutions to counteract them. So lets Begin!

Blinded by the sunshine, we stray from our path and in pursuit of our goals perform illegal and

unconstitutional acts with no regard for the consequences.

Vijay Mallya despite being a multi-millionaire and owner of Kingfisher enterprises committed bank fraud in the hopes of getting richer and richer.

to achieve success. This middle path of extreme pleasure and pain is the need of and call of the hour. It helps us face the sunshine while maintaining our shadow.
