

IMPORTANT CENTRAL GOVERNMENT SCHEMES

JAN DHAN YOJNA



- ❑ August 28, 2014 (Launched Date)
 - ❑ To connect maximum people with banks so that they can be encouraged to save money.
 - ❑ This scheme is operated by the 'Ministry of Finance'.
 - ❑ 45.25 crore (Approx) Accounts have been opened so far till December 2022 (Estimated).
 - ❑ Under the scheme bank does not charge you any fee if the balance is zero.
 - ❑ Accident insurance of ₹ 100000 and general insurance cover of ₹ 30000 is given under the scheme.
 - ❑ As per the latest figures, the amount deposited in Jan Dhan accounts in various banks of the country is more than Rs 1.30 lakh crore.
 - ❑ The participation of women in Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana has been 55.2% (Approx.).
 - ❑ Maximum accounts have been open in UP till october 2022.
- ➡ To remove youth unemployment in the country, and create a system to make youth employable.
- ❑ Under this scheme different types of courses like Artificial Intelligence, 3D Printing, Robotics, Big Data, VR are covered.
 - ❑ This course is completely free.
 - ❑ Youth get personal accident insurance of ₹ 2 lakh under the scheme.

MAKE IN INDIA



- ❑ **Launched:** September 25, 2014
- ❑ The main objective of 'Make in India' scheme is to transform the country into a global manufacturing hub.
- ❑ This initiative is to invite potential investors and partners from across the globe to New India.
- ❑ The share of manufacturing sector in the country's GDP is to be increased from 16% to 25% by the year 2022.

- ❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Commerce and Industry

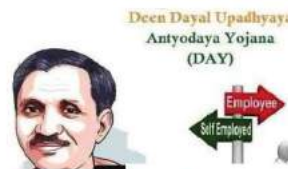
SKILL INDIA MISSION

DEENDAYAL UPADHYAYA ANTYODAYA YOJANA



- ❑ **Launched:** September 25, 2014
- ❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation, Govt. of India

- ❑ **Budget:** 3000 crores
- ❑ **Objective:** The objective of the scheme is to increase livelihood opportunities and reduce rural poverty through skill development and other measures.
- ❑ Social solidarity and institution development.
- ❑ subsidy to the urban poor
- ❑ Shelter for the urban homeless.

SWACHH BHARAT MISSION



- ❑ October 02, 2014
- ❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation
- ❑ The Campaign was launched on the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.
- ❑ The Main objective of this mission is to elimination of open defecation.
- ❑ The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan has achieved a great success in spreading awareness across the country.
- ❑ To provide toilets, separately for boys and girls in all schools.

SANSAD ADARSH GAON YOJANA



- ❑ **Launched:** October 11, 2014
- ❑ Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) was launched on 11th October, 2014 with the aim to translate the comprehensive vision of Mahatma Gandhi about an ideal Indian village into a reality, keeping in view the present context.
- ❑ Under SAGY, Each member of Parliaments adopts a Gram Panchayat and guides its holistic progress giving importance for social development at par with the infrastructure.
- ❑ The Adarsh Grams are to become schools of local development and governance, inspiring these gram panchayat.

MISSION INDRADHANUSH SCHEME



- ❑ **Launched:** December 25, 2014
- ❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Health and Family welfare
- ❑ The scheme was launched with the vision of achieving 90% complete immunization coverage in India by 2022.
- ❑ The fundamental goal of the mission indradhanush is to cover all children under two years and pregnant women, those who are not covered under the universal immunization programme.
- ❑ Indradhanush refers to 7 colours as we know it, the government aims to provide immunity to children under 2 years of age from 7 vaccine-preventable diseases, those are Diphtheria, Tetanus, Typhoid, Cerebral Polio, Hepatitis B, and Measles.

MISSION INDRADHANUSH PLAN 2.0

- ❑ Effective year 2017
- ❑ Immunization coverage of 90% of children under 2 years of age

MISSION INDRADHANUSH PLAN 3.0

- ❑ Effective Year 2020-21
- ❑ The Union Government launched Intensified Mission Indradhanush (IMI) 3.0 in February 2020 to expand the coverage of the National Immunization Programme. The main objective of this mission is to reach the unorganised population for their vaccination as well as to offer the vaccines available under the Universal Immunization Program.

MISSION INDRADHANUSH PLAN 4.0

- ❑ Effective year 2022
- ❑ Annually more than three crore pregnant women and 2.6 crore children are to be covered through Universal Immunization Program (UIP) under the scheme.

PANDIT DEENDAYAL SHRAMEV JAYATE YOJANA

- ❑ October 16, 2014
- ❑ **Ministry :** Ministry of Labour



- ❑ **Objective:** To implement 'Make in India' scheme by encouraging local manufacturers.
- ❑ Reforming labour laws and labour practices to industries
- ❑ Increase in wages limits and pension schemes for labourers across India.

- ❑ January 21, 2015
- ❑ **Main Objective of HRIDAY Yojna**
- ❑ The main objective of HRIDAY is to preserve character of the soul of heritage city and facilitate inclusive heritage linked urban development by exploring various avenues including involving private sector.
- ❑ Preserve and revitalize heritage where any tourists can connect directly with city's unique character.
- ❑ **Budget:** 500 crores

BETI BACHAO, BETI PADHAO



- ❑ January 22, 2015
- ❑ The goal of this scheme is to make girls socially and financially self-reliant through education.
- ❑ Its objective is to prevent the gender-based sex selection and ensuring the protection of a girl child.
- ❑ **Ministries :** Ministry of Women and Child Development, Ministry of Health Family Welfare and Ministry of Human Resource Development.



- ❑ January 22, 2015
- ❑ The Sukanya Samridhi Yojna is a government saving scheme created with the intention to benefit girl child under the initiative called 'Beti Cachao Beti Padhao'.
- ❑ The parent or guardian of the girl child who is 10 years of age or younger can open an account under the scheme.

PRADHAN MANTRI MUDRA YOJANA



- ❑ 8 April 2015
- ❑ To provide credit of upto ₹ 10 lakh to small entrepreneurs and act as a regulator for micro-finance institutions.
- ❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India.

UJALA SCHEME



- ❑ May 1, 2015
- ❑ Under the UJALA initiative, the government provides two payment alternatives for purchasing LED bulb.
- ❑ **Ministry:** Power

ATAL PENSION YOJANA



- ❑ May 09, 2015
- ❑ Monthly pension for people in the unorganised sector in the age group of 18 to 60 years
- ❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Finance

PRADHAN MANTRI JEEVAN JYOTI BIMA YOJANA



- ❑ May 9, 2015
- ❑ Life Insurance of ₹ 2 lakh for the people between age of 18 to 50 years.
- ❑ **Ministry :** Ministry of Finance

SMART CITY YOJANA



- ❑ June 25, 2015
- ❑ To Develop 100 selected cities of the country.
- ❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Urban Development

AMRUT SCHEME



- ❑ 25 June, 2015.
- ❑ The Amrut scheme is an initiative to provide basic amenities to the urban areas to improve the quality of life with major focus to the poor and the disadvantaged.
- ❑ **Ministry :** Ministry of Housing and Urban Development

AMRUT 2.0



- ❑ October 1, 2021
- ❑ Amrut scheme 2.0 upto 2025-26 were approved by the cabinet during october 2021.

- ❑ June 25, 2015
- ❑ To provide financial assistance to all homeless and people living in dilapidated houses.

PRADHAN MANTRI AWAS YOJANA - RURAL



- ❑ November 20, 2016
- ❑ To provide financial assistance to all homeless and people living in dilapidated houses.
- ❑ **Ministry :** Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs

- ❑ July 1, 2015
- ❑ Digital India is a flagship programme of the

government of India with a vision to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.

- ❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology.

- ❑ November 5, 2015
- ❑ An investor can deposit gold for short and long term medium under the gold scheme.
- ❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Finance

- ❑ October, 2015
- ❑ The Pradhan Mantri UDAY scheme has been launched for a sustainable financial and operational growth to residents of unauthorised colonies in Delhi.
- ❑ **Ministry:** Power

- ❑ September 23, 2018

- ❑ August 15, 2019

- ❑ Har Ghar Jal is a scheme initiated by the ministry of Jal Shakti of Government of India under Jal Jeevan mission in 2019 with the aim to provide tap water to every household by 2024.

❑ **Ministry:** Ministry of Jal Shakti.

ATMANIRBHAR BHARAT SCHEME



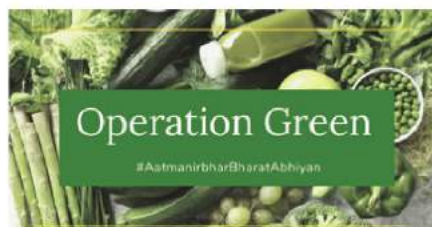
- ❑ May 12, 2020
