Its also called as Hypertextlink. Its shows in Blue color and also underlined. Links are defined into two types-Internal Link and External Link.

3. Multiple: - This is used to select multiple options from the given list.

Q:3: Explain Textarea with an example?

Answer: This is a container tag. It allows the user to input multiple lines of text using the <textarea> tag in the <form> tag to use the text area. Its attributes are ROWS and COLS. The Rows attribute defines the lines of text in the text area and the Cols attribute text area defines the columns of text. This allows the user to define any default text.

Example

Q:4: What is the purpose of action and method in forms?
