Explanations

1. d Fantastic bears no relation to the rest of the words that are synonyms.
2. c Go-getter is an antonym of the other three words.
3. b Spineless is an opposite of the other three words.
4. a Shouting is not the sound of an animal, the rest of the words are.
5. c A driver is a person, the rest of the words denote strategies or moves.
6. d The underlined part has an adjective clause 'which was following us' which describes the 'car' and the main clause 'seems to have disappeared'. The adjective clause should be placed immediately after the noun that it qualifies so that there is no scope for ambiguity.
7. c The word 'whom' modifies 'the girl', hence should be placed immediately after it. Also, the adverb 'extremely' should be used and not 'extreme'.
8. d All choices except (d) have an incorrect word order. The infinitive phrase 'to reach the south pole' has to be correctly placed next to the noun 'man' which it describes.
9. d The infinitive clause, 'to kidnap a prominent diplomat' has been misplaced in choices (a) and (b), hinting that the police might be doing the kidnapping. Choice (c) also suggests that the police have not started the investigation and is incorrect. Choice (d) is the answer as all these ambiguities are resolved in it.
10. d 'The fact' is 'that he was seriously ill' and hence the clause 'that he.....ill' has to be placed after 'the fact'. Choice (d) is the answer as it uses the right structure.
11. d 'poverty' cannot eradicate on its own, but has to be eradicated. Therefore, the correct phrase is 'poverty should be eradicated'.
12. b The word 'that' is not required. 'Wanted to know why' is the right usage.
13. b 'too bad' is incorrect usage and should be replaced by 'so bad', where the word so indicates the extent to which her health was bad.
14. b 'Return back' is wrong because of repetition. It should be either 'come back' or plainly 'return'.
15. b Cakes are 'cut into pieces'.
16. a 'Training' is the opposite of 'Heredity'. Similarly, 'Unnatural' is the opposite of 'Usual'.
17. c Incense emits Fragrance just as Garbage emits a Noxious smell.
18. b The second word in the pair has double the sides of the first word. Triangle - 3 sides, Hexagon - 6 sides; Rectangle - 4 sides, Octagon - 8 sides.
19. c 'Abridge' (shorten) is the opposite of 'Lengthen' and 'Lend' is the opposite of 'Borrow'.
20. c Soup is a liquid. Similarly, oxygen is a gas.
