The motive force of his minority is not humanity and love of their kind, but greed and avarice. This state of things I am attacking with all my might." Gandhiji said. He also said, "i must refuse to insult the naked by giving them clothes they do not need instead of giving them the work they sorely need. The ill-clad or the naked millions of India need no charity, but work."
