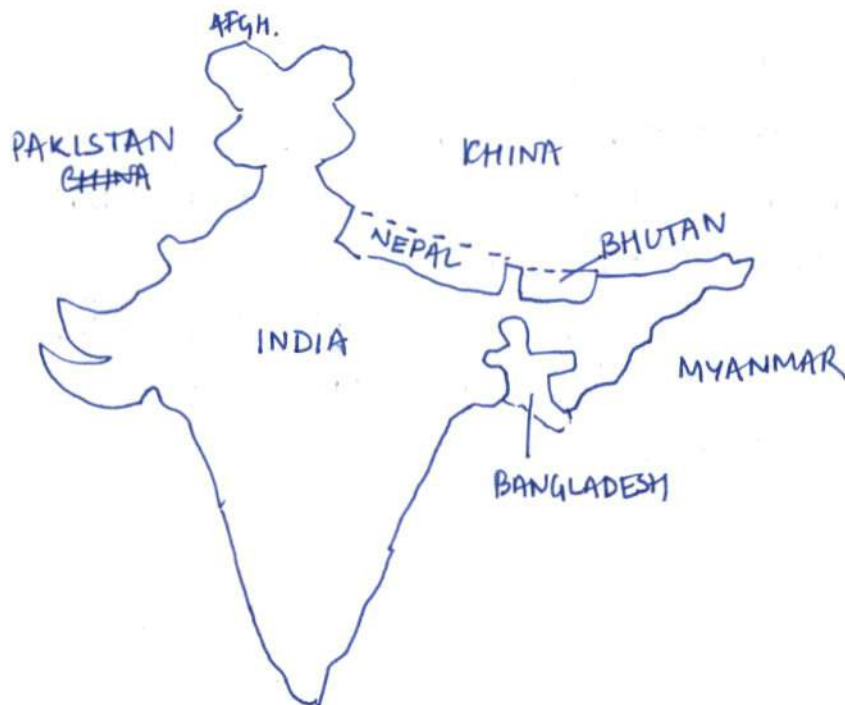

1. India's internal security challenges are intricately linked with the security of the country's borders. Comment. (150 words) 10

India share its border with 7 countries along 15000 kms. namely Pakistan, China, Bangladesh, Nepal, Bhutan, Myanmar, and Afghanistan.

The internal security of India is intricately linked with the security of country's borders as all the neighbouring countries are either hostile, economically depressed or politically instable which can in turn destabilise our country.



The security challenges linked with borders are enhanced as:

- China and Pakistan, both are nuclear powers.
- Cross border terrorism sponsored by Pakistan along borders. EX In J&K.

- Infiltration along borders which support Naxalism, and insurgency in India.
- As India is between the Golden Crescent and Golden triangle, it emerges as a favourable route for drug trafficking.
- Illegal immigration through porous borders creates political and social instability.
Example : Through Bangladesh in Assam.
- The neighbouring countries also emerge as safe havens for other criminal activities along borders.

Since all above problems pose a grave security threat to internal security of India, hence the borders need to be under strict vigilance to maintain security of India.

Several forces like Border Security Force (BSF), Sema Suraksha Bal (SSB) are posted at borders for its security.

2. Surveillance has emerged as a key component to pre-empt threats to national security. In this context, bringing out the issues in the present surveillance framework of India, suggest some measures to address them.

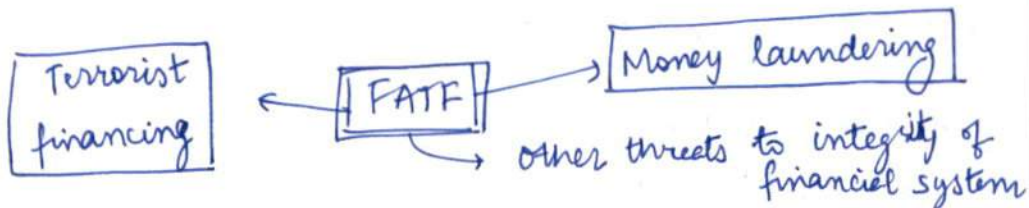

The FATF holds a great significance in fighting terrorism as it help in curbing funding of terrorist activities. Since the terrorist org. require huge funds to carry out violence, the lack of funding will fail their complete organisation

FATF have the following tools to available to fulfill its mandate:

- The listing of countries in Grey list, Black list in order of their steps taken to prevent terrorist financing.
Ex. Recently Pakistan is put in Grey list for its lack of fulfillment of the

- FATF can put sanctions on a nation if it is not complying.
- FATF can pass multilateral conventions to curb terrorist financing.
- There are regional groups under FATF for tackling the terrorism funding at regional level.
Ex. Asia Pacific Group (APG)

India become a member of FATF in 2008 and it chairs APG at regional level.

4. Illustrate the concept and utility of Comprehensive Integrated Border Management System (CIBMS) in tackling the vulnerabilities along the Indo-Myanmar Border. (150 words) 10

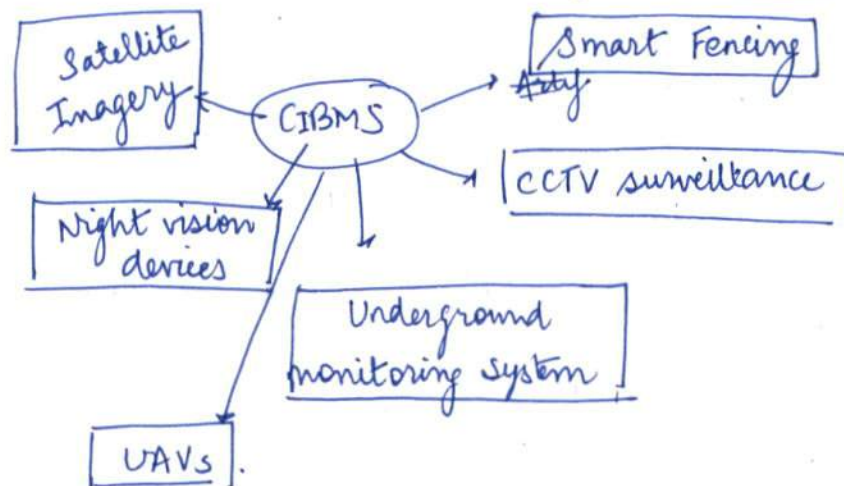
Comprehensive Integrated Border Management system (CIBMS) is a security system which integrates the technology with human force. The CIBMS was introduced aftermath of Pathankot attack in 2016, to check the infiltration along borders and strict surveillance.

Indo-Myanmar borders runs along 45 states of India. The border suffers from the following vulnerabilities :

- FMR : Free Movement Regime :
This allows tribes ^{on} of both sides of border free movement along border till 16 kms.
This is exploited by insurgents to move through the borders freely.
- The insurgents receive training and support from other side of border to carry out violence.
- There is no proper fencing along Indo Myanmar border.
- The riverine areas remain vulnerable without physical barriers and surveillance.
- Difficult Terrain.



CIBMS can help in surveillance of Indo-Myanmar borders as it have the following components:

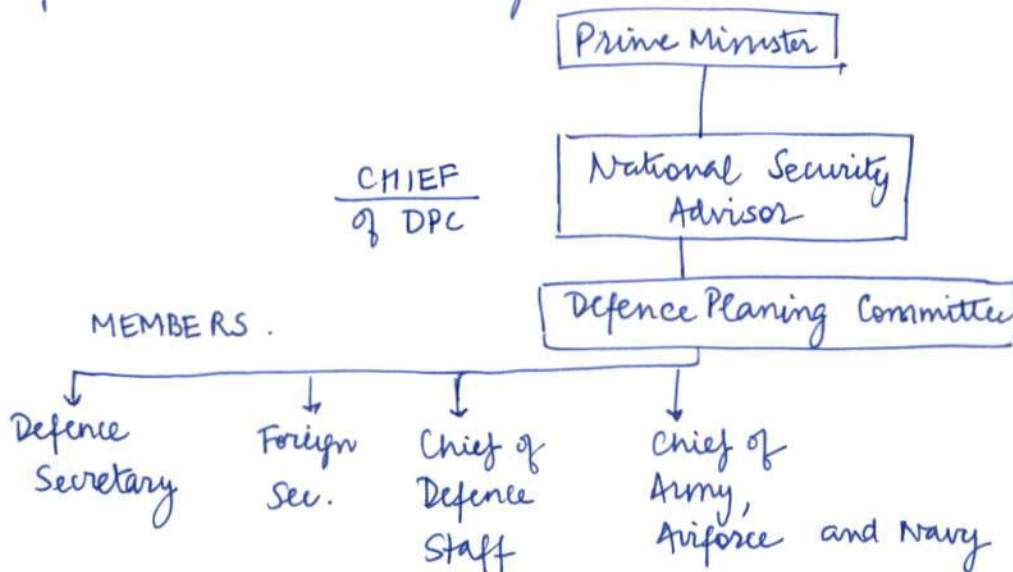


The riverine areas can be fitted with Laser tech. Hence the unfenced area and the riverine areas can be put under vigilance with the help of technology. CIBMS will help in securing those areas which are hard to reach by human force and hence strengthen our border security.

5. Given its structure and mandate, Defence Planning Committee (DPC) aims to move away adhocism towards a more structured defence-planning process. Elaborate. (150 words) 10

But with the constitution of DPC : Defence Planning Committee, it aims to move away from adhocism towards a more structured Defence - Planning process.

The DPC aims at preparing a vision for defence forces along with :

- Encouraging domestic manufacturing in defence
- Providing roadmap for defence forces,

6. Despite allegations of human rights violations under the AFSPA, it is a functional requirement for the army in disturbed areas. Critically discuss.

AFSPA : Armed Forces Special Powers Act was enacted in 1958 for which gives extra-ordinary powers and immunity to armed forces to restore normalcy in disturbed areas.

At present, AFSPA is in force in Jammu & Kashmir, Assam, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and parts of Arunachal.

It is argued that AFSPA which grant powers such as fire on any person acting against law,
• arrest a person without warrant is against the principle of democracy as it lead to human right violations.

- There have been reports of sudden forced disappearances, sexual assault, fake encounters as it is alleged armed forces abuse power.
- AFSPA results in threat to fundamental rights.
- Many committees have suggest the taking away of absolute immunity. like Jeeran Reddy Committee

But still against all these allegations, AFSPA is not withdrawn even after so many decades.

The rationale ^{given} behind enforcing APSPA are :

- The armed forces face a continuous threat in these disturbed areas.
- It is functional requirement of army for securing integrity of country.
- Armed forces face a asymmetric warfare such as ambushes, raids, explosives.

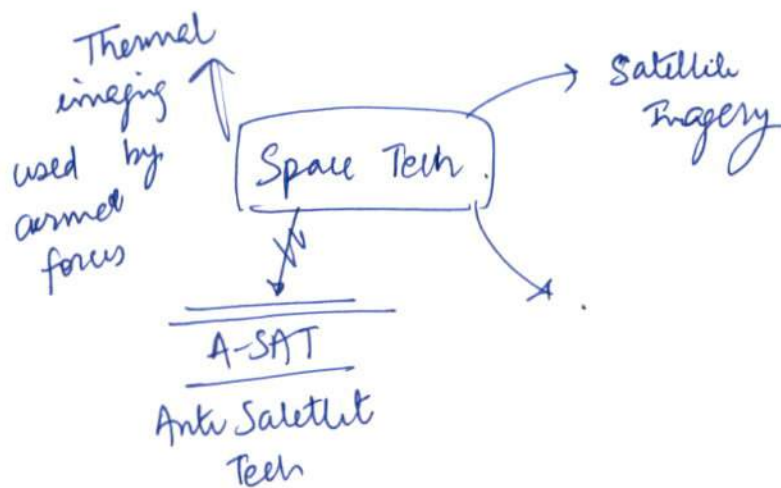
The SC in its judgements have said that there should not be any contradiction in protecting the armed forces through APSPA and the rights of people.

It is evident that APSPA is required and can not be done away with but every death and every case should be properly inquired into to check misuse of power.

Climate Change is the rising threat in present times. Scholars have started arguing that climate change in coming times will pose grave security threats ^{at} national level.

Scholars have argued to declare this as "WARWING WAR".

UNEP has released a document listing ~~seasons~~ threats it can pose:

- 1) Climate Change will lead to increasing sea level which will inundate low lying countries in future.

This will result in disputes regarding maritime boundaries and marine resources between countries.

- 2) Limited Resources on Earth:

Climate Change will lead to over exploitation of resources and as resources are limited, it will result in disputes.

- 3) With depleting resources, inflation will rise leading to protests, riots and other security threats.

4) Livelihood loss and migration

With threat of farmers losing their land to climate change, and livelihood loss, a huge number of people will migrate leading to serious problems.

5) Increasing disasters and in fragile areas will be a threat to nations.6) Some countries with poor institutional mechanisms will not be able to tackle and adapt climate change and hence it may result into civil war.

With above threats in concerns, UN Security Council decided to declare climate change as an international security issue.

This will result in sanctions for countries who will not be complying with the limits by conventions. It may result in economic, political or even military sanctions.

India is firmly against this decision as:

- India has pointed that it is not in the mandate of UNSC and it have failed to fulfill its mandate, so expansion of mandate is not required.

- Issues like climate change should be dealt with by a inclusive group. and not a biased and group of developed nations only.
- India argued that UNFCC should be a perfect forum to discuss the issue.
- The declaration of security issue of climate change is not the need of hour. at present.

As UNEP pointed that climate change will act as a threat multiplier in future but the concerns of India are genuine and they should be taken care of before any big decision.

In past 5 years, we have done 2 Surgical Strikes in Balakot and Pok to tackle the asymmetric warfare.

- Hot pursuits are seen as a 'option now by armed forces.
- India is also trying to expose Pakistan in front of world by diplomatic efforts. by citing ~~as~~ it as a hub of terrorism.

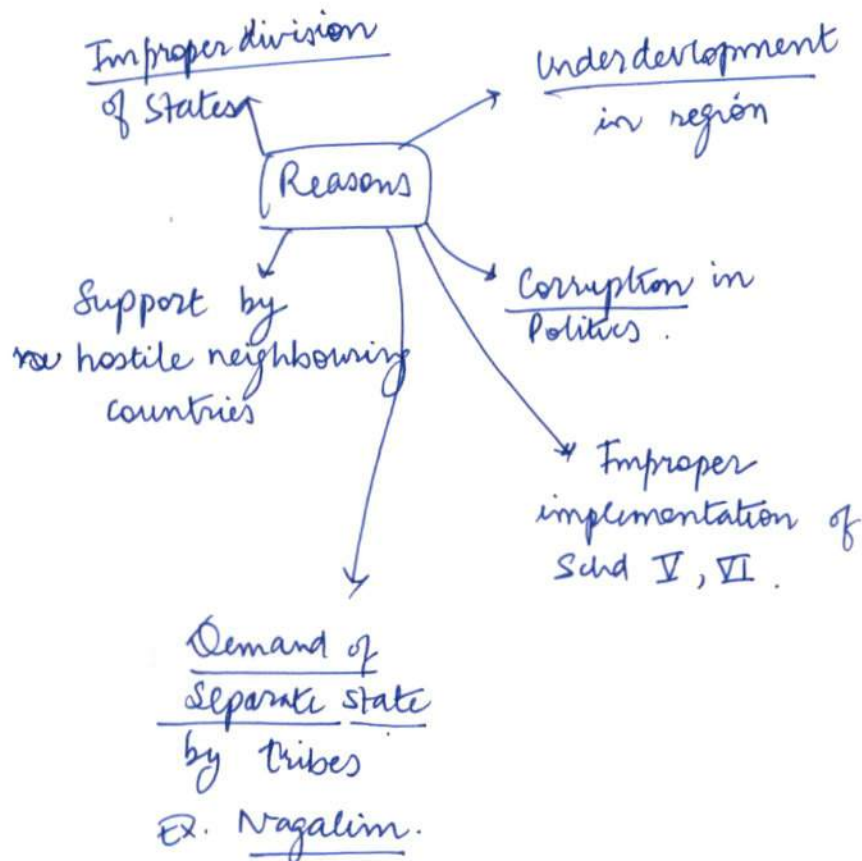

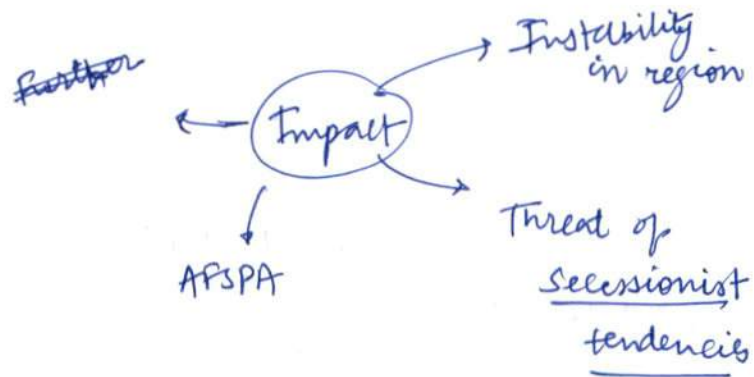
